a) O-19-221 AGL Resources Franchise Agreement Ordinance

Spitler made a motion to place O-19-221, an ordinance granting to Atlanta Gas Light Company the right and franchise to use and occupy the streets and rights of way of the City of Berkeley Lake, for constructing, maintaining, repairing and operating a gas works and distribution system and other necessary means for manufacturing, transmitting, distributing and selling of manufactured, natural or comingled gas within and through the City of Berkeley Lake, and fixing the terms and conditions of such grant; to provide provisions governing the franchise fee calculation; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes, on first read. McDaniel seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

b) O-19-222 Budget Amendment for 2018

<u>Rozier</u>: O-19-222 is a housekeeping measure to identify a final status of expenses and revenues for 2018. I am requesting that council place the item on first read and to schedule a public hearing regarding the amendment for April 18th at 8:00 PM.

McDaniel made a motion to place O-19-222, an ordinance to amend the budget for the year 2018, to repeal conflicting ordinances, to provide for an effective date and for other purposes, on first read and to hold a public hearing regarding the amendment on April 18, 2019 at 8:00 PM. Spitler seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Mark Jacobson, 547 Lakeshore Drive, spoke briefly about renovations to the water wheel in Henderson Nature Sanctuary.

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ADJOURNMENT
